## INTRODUCTION








### **2. Length of Service:**

Average Length of Service	9.3 Years










## 5. Rate the ICT facilities available in the college for technological upgraded pedagogical environment:



**7. Rate the overall hygiene and cleanliness of the classrooms and basic amenities in the college:**




